GUARD SYSTEM

On the way we will use the usual surveillance system on board: the watches. You will learn how they are organized, dangers and precautions at night and finally how to become watch leader.

METEOROLOGY

There are many miles to cover, you will do daily weather analysis using satellite communications, grib files and direct observation.

As you progress through the RYA training scheme, you will need to accumulate miles for Yachtmaster courses.


On each of the crossings you will accumulate miles in tidal waters.
